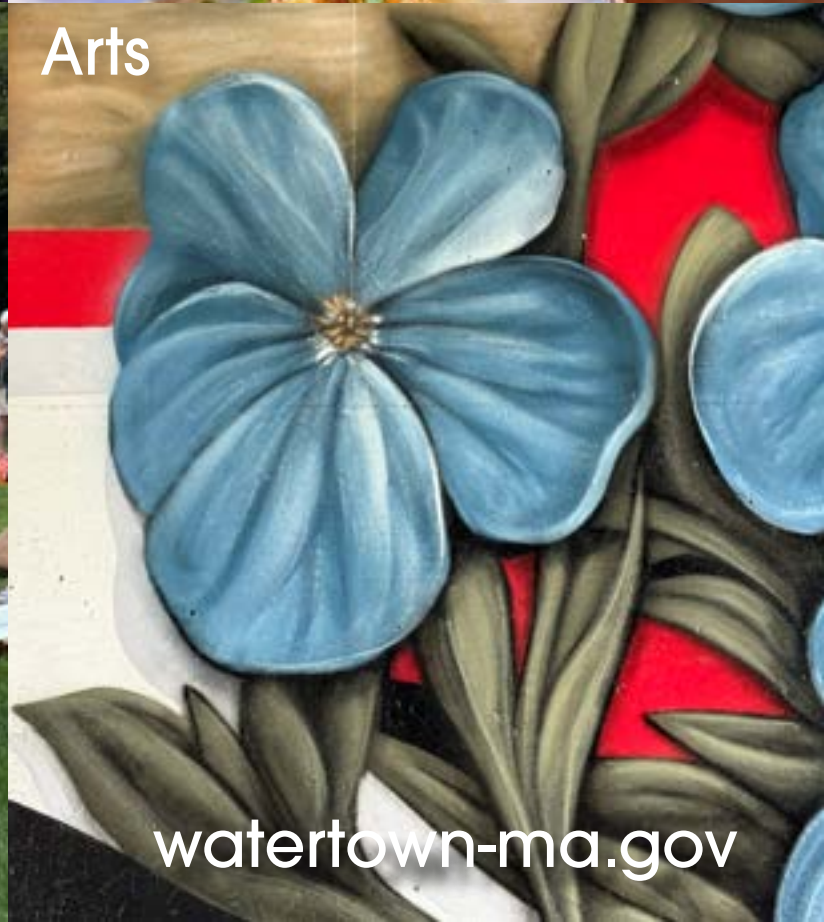

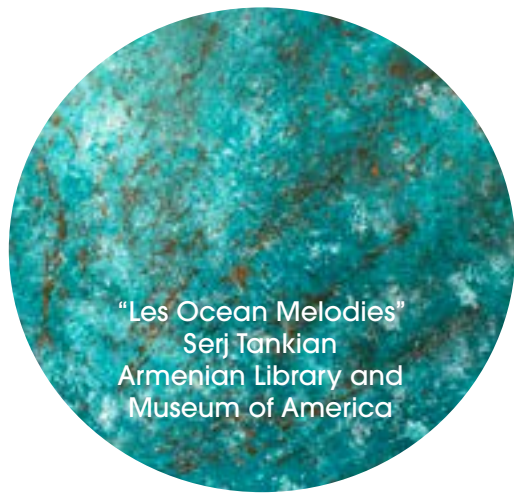

On July 19, 1776, the new United States signed a treaty of military aid and alliance with the Mi'kmaq and Maliseet indigenous nations. Under this treaty, these peoples agreed to fight on the American side against the British. The treaty was signed at the Edmund Fowle House in Watertown and is the longest continuously-honored treaty in the U.S.

Commemorate this partnership with the City of Watertown and the Massachusetts, Mi'kmaq, and Maliseet peoples.
